

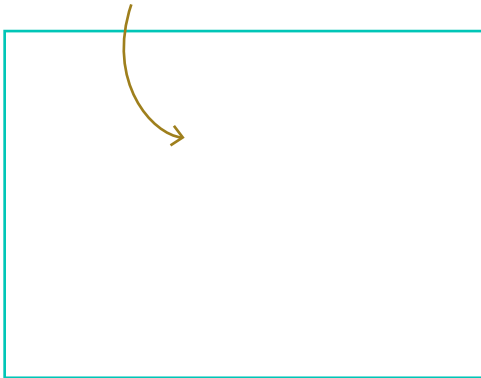

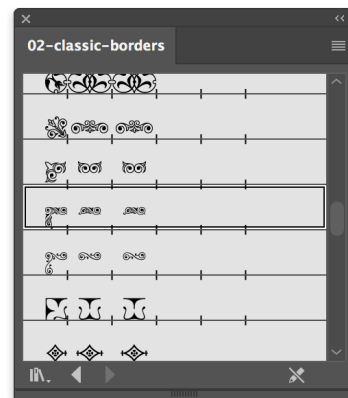
CREATE DECORATIVE BORDERS

WITH ILLUSTRATOR BRUSHES

1- Select a shape

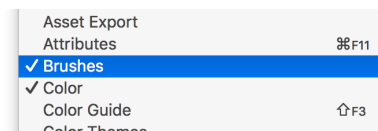


2 - Select a border style from the Illustrator Brushes Panel.

Show Brushes Panel,

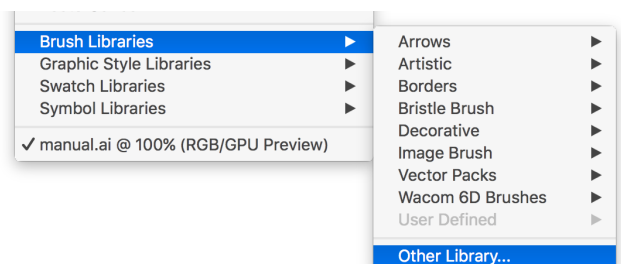

Load Vectorian Borders

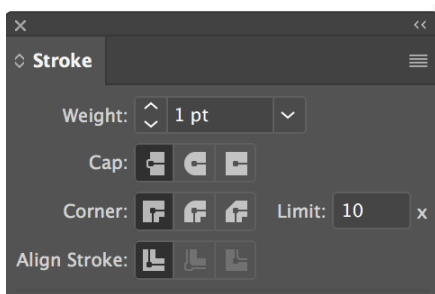
- Go to: [Window > Brushes Libraries > Other library](#)

Change Borders Size

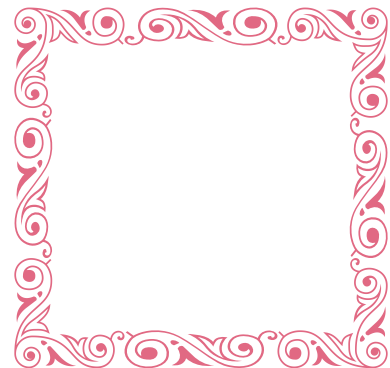
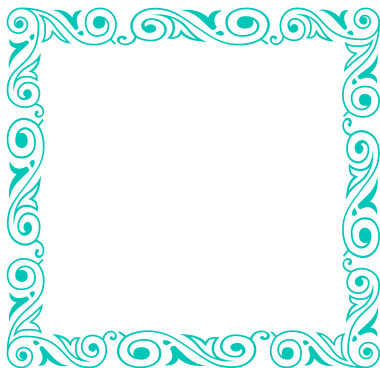
- Select shape
- Change Stroke weight in the Stroke panel



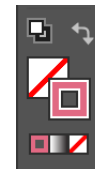
Applying 1px weight to borders

- Change stroke color in tools panel

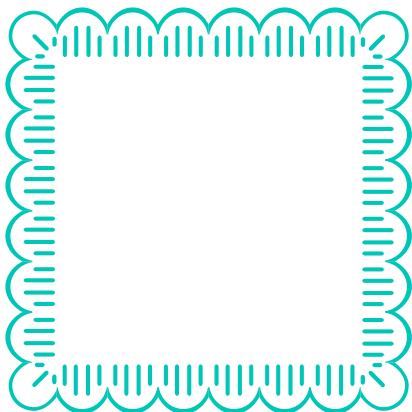


Changing stroke color

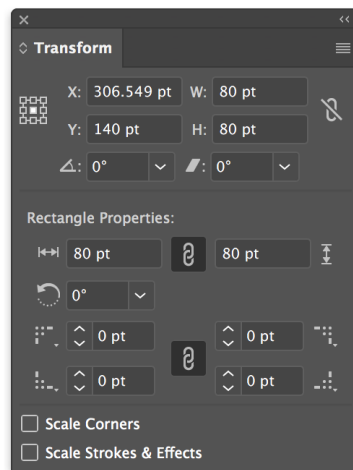
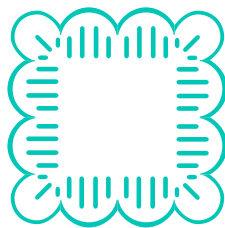


Scale borders width while resizing

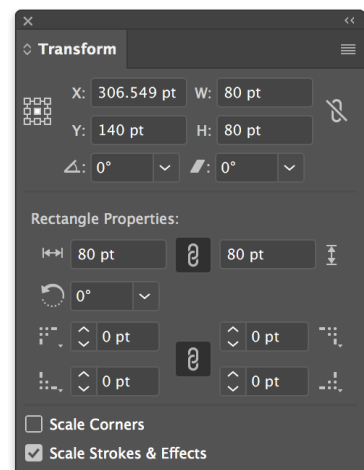
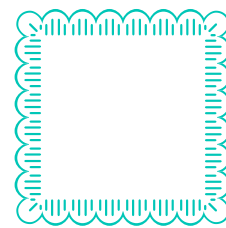
By checking the “Scale Strokes and Effects” in the Transform Panel, you can have the borders adjusting their weight when you resize a shape.

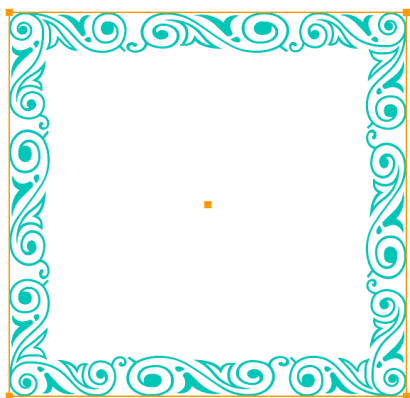
After, “Scale Strokes and Effects” unchecked



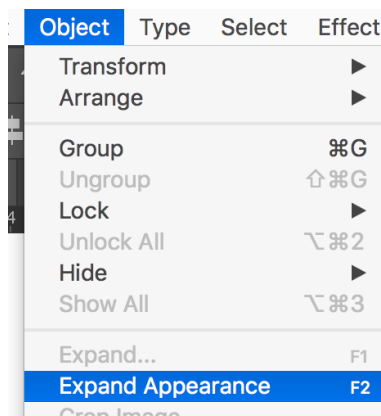
After, “Scale Strokes and Effects” checked

Expand Borders

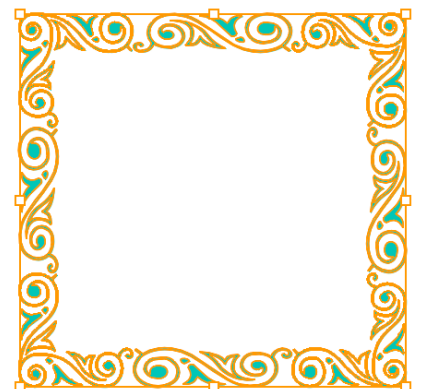
If you need to export borders to another software, or to apply complex effects on borders, expand them first.
